## NOTES:

A complete scout uniform consists of:

- Class A BSA shirt with current rank badge & 955 unit numerals.
- **THE SCOUT'S LAST NAME WILL BE WRITTEN IN MARKER AT THE BOTTOM HEM OF THE SHIRT DIRECTLY RIGHT OR LEFT OF THE BUTTON LINE.**
- Official BSA or O.D. Green shorts or pants
- **THE SCOUT'S LAST NAME WILL BE WRITTEN IN MARKER ON THE INSIDE OF THE WAISTBAND DIRECTLY RIGHT OR LEFT OF THE ZIPPER.**
- TROOP 955 neckerchief with scout's name written on back of embroidery
- Neckerchief slide
- Boy Scout belt – web type or alternate BSA leather with BSA type buckle
- BSA Scout socks

Initials on the toes of socks goes a long way toward eliminating “lost” socks.

When dispersing cash in envelopes think SMALL BILLS. Large bills don't buy much in the woods! Singles and fives work best.

Have THE SCOUT address a couple envelopes to you before packing. It is amazing how many scouts have no idea of how a letter should be addressed.
