

# Troop 955, Quartermaster

The Quartermaster keeps track of troop equipment and sees that it is in good working order.

## Qualifications:

- Appointed by Senior Patrol Leader with Scoutmaster approval
- First Class rank or higher

## Troop Quartermaster duties:

- Establish and maintain troop equipment inventory.
- Check equipment to ensure it is in good repair.
- Issue necessary equipment at all outings, keep records of who the equipment was issued to and see that it is returned in good order.
- Insure that records of equipment issued are maintained at outings, even those outings the quartermaster does not attend. Establish a list of items to be supplied by the troop for every patrol box.
- Ensure that every patrol has been issued a patrol box.
- Establish a system wherein patrols are held accountable for lost or damaged items.
- Plan and carry out, in coordination with the scoutmaster, an annual 'equipment day' wherein scouts and parents come together to perform maintenance, cleaning, inventory and other equipment related functions.
- SERVE AS CZAR for Turkey in the Sand
- Suggest new or replacement items.
- Participate in outings. Attendance expectation 75%
- Attend troop meetings. Attendance expectation 75%
- Set a good example as a leader
- Wear the field uniform (class A) correctly to all regular troop meetings, outings and religious services.
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law.
- Show Scout spirit.
